EVENING SERVICE 6:00 PM:

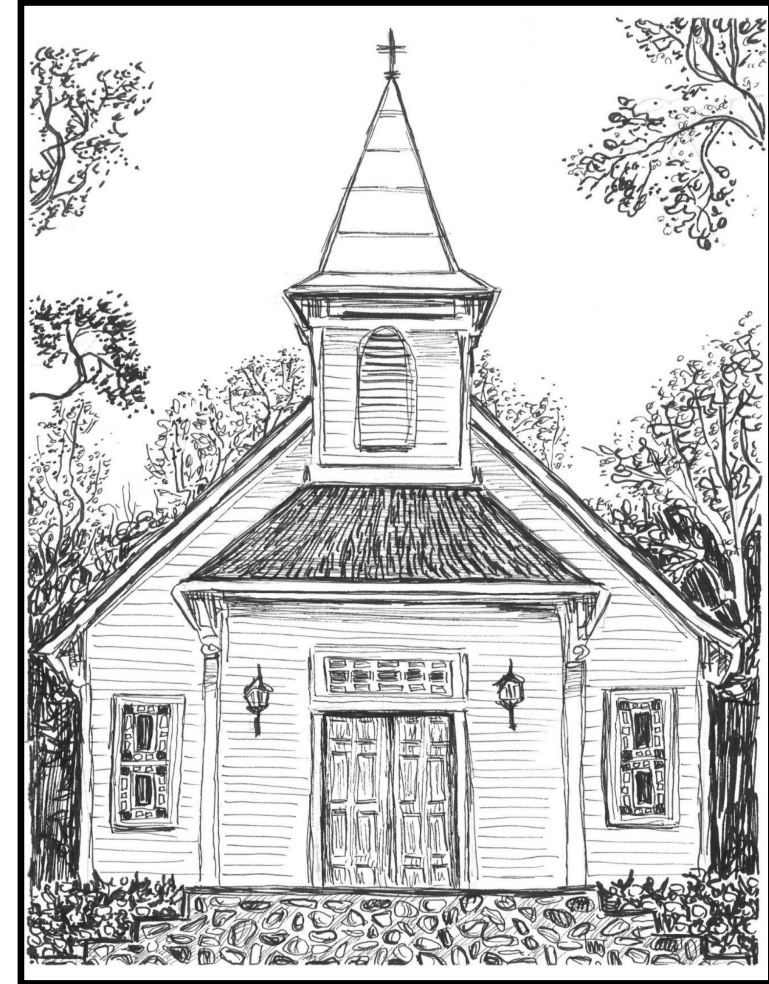

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Based on Psalm 102
