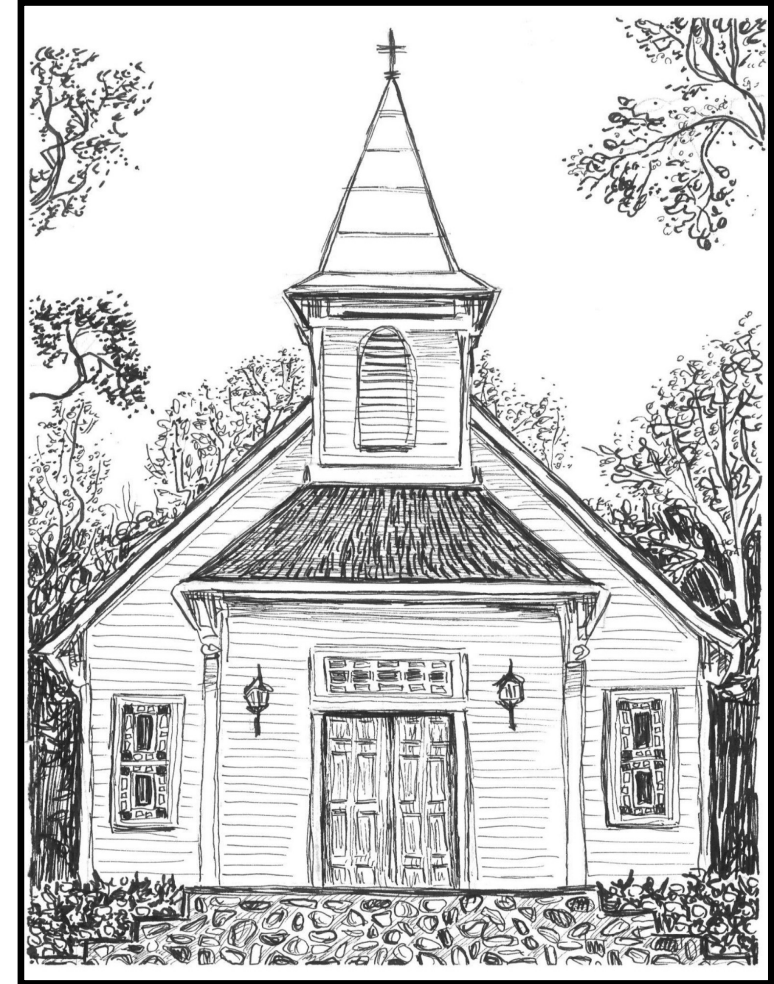


Evening Service 6:00 PM:
